

Advice for Parents

- My child has a high temperature, a new cough, shortness of breath, loss of sense of smell or taste, sore throat, headaches or diarrhoea
- My child has tested positive for COVID 19
- My child was sent for a COVID19 test, the result is negative but my child is still displaying symptoms
- Someone in my household is unwell and may have COVID19
- Someone in my household is being tested for COVID19
- Someone in my household was tested for COVID19 and the result is positive



Do not send any of your children to school

All children must stay at home

- My child was sent for a COVID19 test, the test is negative and my child is symptom free
- Someone in my household was tested for COVID19 and the result is negative



All of your children can attend school

Close Contacts:

- My child has been identified as a close contact and is displaying symptoms
Do not send any of your children to school and contact your GP
- My child has been identified as a close contact and is not displaying symptoms
Do not send your child to school for 14 days.
Your child may return to school when they have tested negative 10 days after last being in contact with the person who tested positive AND have no symptoms.
Your other children may attend school during this time.

If any of your children or a member from your family tests positive for COVID19 please inform the school immediately.
