Fr. Devine: We pray to God, our Father in heaven, that the Holy Spirit will give our Confirmation candidates the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Right Judgement and Courage, the Spirit of Knowledge and Reverence.

Dear Lord, may the Holy Spirit fill them with the Spirit of Won-

der and Awe in your presence.

All: Amen.

Candles are now extinguished. Candidates sit down.

Opening Ritual

(read by Fiona, candles brought forward by Kevin, Dylan, Emma and Richard)

Fr. Devine: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.

Fr. Devine: The Lord be With You

All: And with your Spirit.

Principal: I wish to extend a very special welcome to the candidates for Confirmation. You were welcomed into the family of God many years ago when you came to be baptised. Now you are preparing for another, very important, sacrament in your life. Confirmation is; God calling you to be an adult in the eyes of the Church. God will give you the gift of the Holy Spirit which will give you the courage and strength you will need to build His kingdom of love, peace and justice here on Earth. God will depend on you to do His work to the best of your ability and the Holy Spirit is given to you to help you in that all important job. Like Jesus, you will be a light to the world, leading people out of darkness and showing them, by your example, that God is important and meaningful. We are now going to have a Gospel reading.

Gospel Reading:

Children's Promises



Fr. Devine: I now invite those who are preparing for Confirmation to make certain promises regarding their readiness to prepare to make a commitment to live as workers for the Kingdom.

Will you remember to pray to God our Father, to help you to love as he has asked?

Children: I will.

Fr. Devine: Will you try hard at home to give good example to the younger members of your family, to work for peace rather than disagreement with all, to respect and obey your parents?

Children: I will.

Fr. Devine: Will you try to ensure that you offer help whenever it is needed, that no one is left out, that you play fairly for school, club and at home?

Fr. Devine: Will you try to take responsibility at home, at school or in the neighbourhood?

Fr. Devine: The Baptismal candles may now be lit from the Paschal candle.

Lighting of the Candles Ceremony.

Principal and Teacher both light tapers from the Paschal candle.

They proceed to the end of the first row and hand the lit taper to the parents. The parents then light the Baptismal candles, which the child is holding, from the taper and pass it onto the next parent. They will then hand it back to the Teacher/Principal who hands it to the next row. This continues until all the Baptismal candles are lit. All parents and children remain seated for this process.
